- 2 Attending For First Time: Nobody was attending the meeting for the first time.
- **3 Approval of the Minutes from Meeting 348:** The minutes were duly approved.
- **4 Matters arising from Meeting 348 not covered elsewhere:** There were no matters arising that were not covered elsewhere.
